

Burner is a Ukrainian investment fund that provides financing in the format of Private Equity (growth financing).

A unique feature of Burner is the ability not only to provide financial support but also to strengthen startup teams with its years of expertise in launching successful IT products.

Foundation Story

Burner became a logical continuation and structuring of the investment activities of the international IT company Boosta. This direction began developing in 2017 and reached a new level in 2022.

Among the projects that have already received investments are the digital agency WeRush, SEO-agency SeoProfy, iGaming affiliate company TraffBand, and others. In total, over 16 projects have been funded since 2022.

In 2023, Burner ranked in the <u>TOP-10 Ukrainian IT investors of 2022-2023</u> according to AIN.UA.

Fund Priorities

- → Traffic-driven businesses
- → Focus on markets in Western Europe and the Americas with a volume of \$300 million or more
- → Operations in B2C or B2C2C formats

Burner is open to considering funding requests of up to \$1 million at the start, with the possibility of cash-in financing up to \$3 million over 2 years from the start of collaboration.

Burner places particular emphasis on projects in the fields of iGaming, Lead Generation, Finance to Social Discovery.

Referral Program of Burner

Burner has a referral program that allows you to earn a financial reward for recommending a startup, provided a deal is later signed with it:

- → \$5000 for recommending a company at the pre-seed, seed, or pre-A stage (investments up to \$1 million)
- → \$10000 for recommending a company at the Growth, Series A/B/C stage (investments over \$1 million)
